It was announced that there is going to be a reduction of aircraft from the fleet, with the impact being a devastating number of redundancies. Tomorrow we have been invited to a consultation meeting, where we will be advised of further details of the redundancies and the bases affected. As always, Unite oppose compulsory redundancies and will work hard to ensure a meaningful consultation takes place. We will update you further following the briefing tomorrow. There will be a National Branch meeting for Unite cabin crew members at the Crowne Plaza Hotel at Manchester Airport at 16.30L tomorrow (Wednesday 10th October).

Reps will be in attendance to answer any questions that you may have. Other meetings will be arranged around the country in due course and as required by our members.
