



UNITE CONSULTATION UPDATE 23

12th June 2013

Dear Colleague,

Following the planned mitigation meeting today, the great news is that the vast majority of cabin crew redundancies have now been eliminated. As you know, from the start of the consultation your Unite reps challenged the business rationale put forward by the Company and insisted that no redundancies could be realistically discussed until the Winter '13/'14 flying program was known. Through our perseverance and your continued support and trust over the last seven months, we have reached a position where there are only now 17.4 FTE UK wide potential redundancies. There is actually an increase in the required establishment for W'13/'14 on W'12/'13. We always believed based on the wider business projections that this would be the case. Please see the TCX communication on Xplorer regarding specific numbers.

We have another meeting next week on June 19th and we will maintain the position that no one has to leave the business who does not want to, as the above figures do not as yet include the now confirmed LPA contract and M.O.D. flights.

We are so pleased for all of our members. We know this has been a stressful time for everyone. For those members who are still affected, the work for us still continues, but this reduction in numbers is a fantastic achievement for us and the position we have maintained throughout this difficult and lengthy consultation period.
