Following on from yesterday's mitigation meeting and the recent company memo, a further meeting is planned with the Company for next Tuesday (July 30th) to continue mitigation discussions. Your Reps are appalled that the Company are using the outstanding redundancies as a bargaining chip to achieve their cost saving initiatives. Please see the letter (published alongside this memo on TCXUnite.com) from the Unite Chairman to the General Manager.

We would like to reassure those crew who still remain at risk that if the Company serve notice on you on August 1st, nothing changes from the position that you are currently in. Meetings will continue and efforts will not cease until every last job is saved. Unite will continue to attend mitigation meetings throughout August, September and beyond, if this is necessary.

Your Unite Reps, with the faith and trust of you its members, has already saved over 200 people from these unnecessary redundancies and will not rest until the job is done.
